Cable and Diamond Scarf for North Ronaldsay Aran Wool

Materials

one hank North Ronaldsay Aran yarn
(200 to 250 g)
pair 5.5 mm needles
row counter

Measurements

about 7.5” wide and 56” long (adjustable)

Abbreviations

sts - stitches k - knit p - purl
m1 - make 1 by picking up the strand before
the next stitch and knitting into the back of it

Tension

38 sts across the pattern gives a scarf about 7.5”
wide. Twice through the pattern (24 rows) is
about 4”.



Working from a Chart

Each square represents one stitch. A blank square is worked as a knit stitch when the right side is facing and a purl stitch when the wrong side is facing. A filled square is worked as a purl stitch when the right side is facing and a knit stitch when the wrong side is facing. The chart is read from the bottom up. When working to and fro, read right side rows from right to left and wrong side rows from left to right.

The Scarf

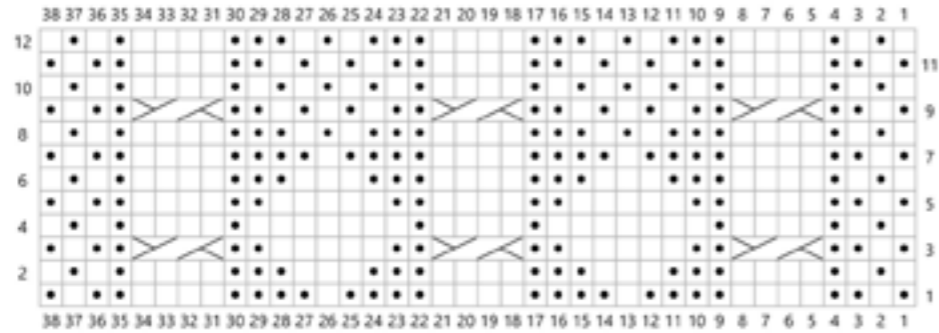
With 5.5 mm needles cast on 35 sts. Work as follows:




row 1: p1, *k1, p1. Repeat from * to the end of the row

rows 2 and 3 as row 1

row 4: (p1, k1) three times, m1, (p1, k1) six times, m1, (p1, k1) five times, m1, (p1, k1) three times, p1. 38 sts

Now work from the chart, noting that the pattern has a 12 row repeat.



-  (blank) k on right side, p on wrong side
-  p on right side, k on wrong side
-  C4B - put next 2 sts on a cable needle and leave at the back of the work, k2, k2 from cable needle

Chart

Row 1: P1, k1, p2, (k4, p4, k1, p4) twice, k4, p2, k1, p1. (38 sts)

Row 2: (P1, k1) twice, (p4, k3, p3, k3) twice, p4, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 3: P1, k1, (p2, C4B, p2, k5) twice, p2, C4B, p2, k1, p1.

Row 4: P1, k1, P1, (k1, p4, k1, p7) twice, k1, p4, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 5: P1, k1, (p2, k4, p2, k5) twice, p2, k4, p2, k1, p1.

Row 6: Repeat row 2.

Row 7: Repeat row 1.

Row 8: (P1, k1) twice, (p4, k3, P1, k1, P1, k3) twice, p4, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 9: (P1, k1, p2, C4B, p2, k1, P1, k1) twice, P1, k1, p2, C4B, p2, k1, p1.

Row 10: ((P1, k1) twice, p4, (k1, p1) twice, k1) twice, (P1, k1) twice, p4, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 11: (P1, k1, p2, k4, p2, k1, P1, k1) twice, P1, k1, p2, k4, p2, k1, p1.

Row 12: Repeat row 8.

Continue in pattern until the work measures 55" or about 1" less than the required length, finishing after a 6th row.

Continue as follows:

row 1 (p1, k1) twice, p1, k2tog, (p1, k1) five times, p1, k2tog, (p1, k1) five times, p1, k2tog, (p1, k1) twice, p1.

row 2 p1, *k1, p1. Repeat from * to the end of the row

row 3 as row 2

row 4 cast off in pattern.

Finishing. Wash the scarf and pin to shape while wet. Allow to dry.
